







The Situation

From the July 2022 monsoon season until now Sindh has faced three spells of moderate to heavy rains. These heavy rains affected several districts of Sindh especially: Thatta, Badin, Khairpur, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Sukkur, and Ghotki. Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy fall) occurred in Sindh and heavy rains continued to cause great damage in several districts of Sindh on 27th July 2022 the Sukkur and Ghotki were epicanthic areas where huge rainfall occurred and damaged the Houses, livestock, and water standing in their areas.

Monsoon rains are likely to continue during the week and weaken in Sindh from 28th July 2022.

Rapid Assessment of Losses/Damages

In pertinent to this, SRSO Monitoring and Evaluation Section under PPRP Program successfully conducted the settlement and Household Based Initial Rapid Assessment (IRA) survey for assessing the losses/damages. The flash floods of 2020 have further devastated the already fragile and poor communities and have caused devastation in the south and southeastern districts of Sindh. Several Union Councils and Talukas are severely affected in District Sanghar, Khairpur, Sukkur, Ghotki, Badin, and Thatto.

Relief Activities'

Ration/Food Bags

The marginalized and affected community due to heavy rain have nothing to feed and food insecurity increased, so SRSO initiated the relief work by distributing the ration bags among affected community specially for Local Protection Bandh and Dam Breaches affected community.



Stitched Suits

The affected community has also lost their possessions, Food insecurity has increased and have lost their foods for children and women. So, under PPRP Program's intervention of Vocational Training Program they have already stitched, so they distributed the clothes also.

• Relief Work

In connection with the relief work, the SRSO Khairpur, CEO directed the field team to start relief work in terms of Ration bags and stitched clothes distribution at Kotdiji where protection Bandh and Local Dam breaches devastations occur.

The stitched clothes were distributed in Union Councils: UC Faqir Jalalani Taluka KotDiji

In Khairpur at affected locations, DM distributed 200 Stitched clothes to the poorest rain-affected households.




