SRSO is mobilizing its limited resources and staff to scale up its assistance in Pakistan to support local communities and refugees in areas devastated by the catastrophic floods.

Affected people told SRSO staff about their traumatic and scarring experiences as rain and flood waters swept away their possessions in minutes. Those who could rush to safety on the higher ground without being able to rescue belongings. SRSO is continuing to support the community, PLW women, children, senior citizens, and the community affected by flooding. During the past four weeks, SRSO districts teams have initiated rescue and relief operations in this challenging time where there is no road infrastructure, everywhere there is water and teams are working on boats, local vehicles (donkey carts, etc) by traveling across flood impacted areas to attend critical people rescues and assist local community for survival.

SRSO's limited relief assistance is a sign of solidarity with the organized community and its people living in these areas.

Shelter, clean drinking water, and food are among the most urgently needed items in the aftermath of the floods.


